SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

The Cathedral Basilica of Santiago de Compostela is part of the Metropolitan Archdiocese of Santiago de Compostela and is an integral part of the World Heritage Site of Santiago de Compostela in Galicia, Spain. The cathedral is the burial place of Saint James the Greater, one of the apostles of Jesus Christ. It is one of the few churches in the world built over the tomb of an apostle; the others are St. Peter's Basilica in Vatican City, the Basilica of St. Thomas in Chennai (India), and the Basilica of St. John in Izmir (Turkey).

The archcathedral basilica has historically been a place of pilgrimage on the Way of St. James since the Early Middle Ages and marks the traditional end of the pilgrimage route. The building is a Romanesque structure, with later Gothic and Baroque additions.
